A house has been purchased in downtown Indianapolis, and is in the process of being renovated. It is to provide both a safe, supportive Christian based environment, and relief from the elements and perils of living on the streets, for those homeless individuals who are seeking employment and a chance to improve themselves and become a more productive member of society.

It will also provide basic comforts, and life skills which include, but are not limited to:

- * Training classes in job search and interviewing skills
- * A weekly introductory Bible Study to encourage a relationship with Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior.
- * Mature, Christian Men to mentor and support the Occupants, as well as enforcing the rules of the house and insuring safety and integrity for all who reside there.



Continuing Activities

- * Distributing food, clothing, blankets and other necessary items, on a daily basis, in the downtown area.
- * Free eye exams and glasses--limited number monthly.
- * Serving hot meals on an occasional basis. We would like to focus on serving a monthly hot meal in the downtown area or at the **H.I.M. House**.
